Balsam Range is **Buddy Melton** (fiddle, vocals); **Darren Nicholson** (mandolin, octave mandolin, vocals); **Dr. Marc Pruett** (banjo); **Tim Surrett** (bass, dobro, vocals); and **Caleb Smith** (guitar, vocals). The five original members are all acoustic musicians and singers from western North Carolina.

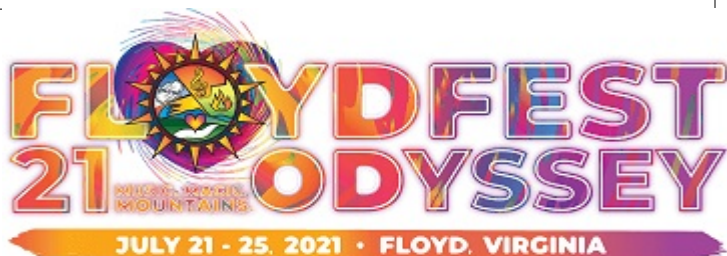

Bluegrass duet **Starlett and Big John** have been signed to a 2-CD deal at Turnberry Records.

The duo is comprised of 38-year music veteran and Virginian, **Big John Talley**, who has performed with various outfits including **New Dominion Bluegrass**, and whose performance resume includes many appearances with **Bill Monroe and The Bluegrass Boys** – including at the Grand Ole Opry--as well as with **Jackie Phelps** (Hee Haw), **Tater Tate** and **Jodi Rainwater**. Guitarist Talley is joined by the talented **Starlett Boswell Austin**, a singer since childhood recognized as bassist and vocalist with **Lawson Creek Grass**.



Cole Quest And The City Pickers are a group of New York City musicians connected by friendship and a love of bluegrass. **Cole Quest**, grandson of the folk icon **Woody Guthrie**, has brought together a collection of eclectic pickers who have gained recognition on the local scene. Performing original tunes as well as traditional favorites, the City Pickers bring their special brand of high-spirited talent with upbeat, knee-slapping energy and a high lonesome sound that'll leave you wanting more. *Self (En)Titled* contains witty originals and crucial covers for the modern listener.

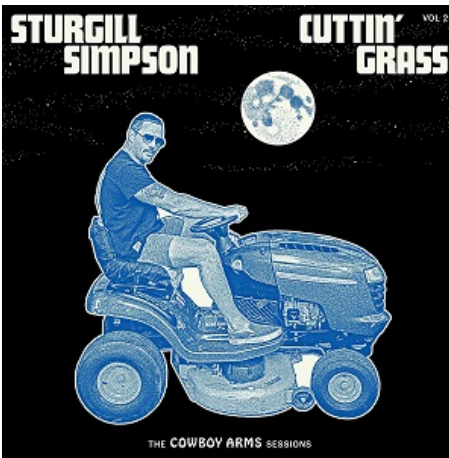
